Friday Morning Breakouts (Breakouts #1)

1. Prayer Practice (practicing a different prayer each day) Dag Sewell

Of all the commands of Jesus, it's hard to find one more direct and clear than Matthew 6:9, "You should pray like this." Does that mean praying using the exact words that follow is the only way Christians should pray? Why or why not? Can we critique Jesus's teaching on prayer in the same way we critique other people's teaching on prayer? Why or why not?

2. Engaging Worldviews in Evangelism Sean Richins

Ever feel like we're using the same words but meaning completely different things? Even when we agree, does it feel like we're still not on the same page? Everyone has a worldview.
